The normal daily activities consist of: Daily studying and writing. Preparing Bible lessons and Pacific Islands Bible College (PIBC) courses. Setting up gospel meetings and workshops in different countries with local brethren. Setting up PIBC courses with local brethren in each country and locations. Making hotel and rental vehicle reservations for PIBC instructors in each country and location. Corresponding to encourage churches and brethren who are facing problems or challenges. Writing and preparing materials such as tract packets to be used in different countries of the Pacific. Writing and preparing Bible materials for adults, teenagers, and children. Then there are many other works that keep us busy daily.

We will be working in: **Saipan, Northern Mariana Islands:**

Teaching Pacific Islands Bible College courses nightly, a weekend workshop for edifying the Church, daily teaching and encouraging members, teaching and preaching on Sundays. Richard Harp from the Tara congregation in Jonesboro, GA will be working with us. **Majuro, Marshall Islands:** Teaching PIBC course nightly, a weekend workshop for edifying the Church, daily teaching and encouraging members, teaching and preaching on Sundays. I will be working with local missionaries David & Loyce Smith. **Leone, American Samoa:** visiting weak and struggling Christians, Bible studies with non-Christians, and conducting a Gospel Meeting. I will be working with the local missionaries the Randy English family, the Rocco Pierce family, and our beloved brethren.

Going back and visiting churches in Labasa, Nabouwalu, and Savusavu, Fiji Islands: Visiting these congregations to edify and strengthen the body of Christ in these places. **In Savusavu, Fiji Islands:** Conducting daily Bible classes and preaching in a Gospel Meeting in Savusavu, Fiji Islands. I will be working with our native brethren here. **Funafuti, Tuvalu Islands:** Doing much evangelistic work such as giving our tract packets and enrolling people in Bible correspondence courses, studying with Christians to encourage and strengthen them, conducting a group Bible study nightly to teach non-Christians, teaching and preaching on Sundays. Avery and Indie Jones will be work with us here. **Suva, Fiji Islands:** We will be visiting Christians to

encourage and strengthen, conducting one-on-one Bible studies, teaching PIBC courses nightly, teaching and preaching for different congregations on Sundays. Scott Cain will be working with us here. **Ambae, Vanuatu Islands:** We will be teaching PIBC courses daily, encouraging and teaching weak Christians, teaching the lost, teaching and preaching on Sundays. Pat Cowden will be working with me here. **Easter Island:** Where I will be taking Josh Blackmer and Troy Spradlin on our first trip to evangelize this country with the goal of planting an indigenous church there. This will be a survey trip where we will be learning all we can about the country, culture, customs, and people. We will also be saturating Easter Island with the gospel by giving out tract packets, enrolling people in Bible correspondence courses, and teaching the gospel to people.

In 2010 we will be working in 10 locations and 7 countries of the Pacific Islands. It will be a challenging year with many co-workers working directly with us and others working on their own in the Pacific. Other co-workers: Stacy & Kathy Ferguson who work with us in Pacific Islands Bible College will be working in Tarawa, Kiribati; Koror, Palau; and Labasa, Fiji. Steve Vice who is the local preacher at Forest Park will be in Moen, Chuuk. Ray Paseur and Scott Crockett will be in Apia, Samoa.
